Key Responsibilities of Senior Chef de Partie

- Take responsibility for the Bar/Brasserie section, including service, presentation, menu creation, specials, standards and gross profit margins;
- Take full responsibility and accountability for the kitchen in the absence of the Head Chef;
- Support the Head Chef and Sous Chef in delivering banqueting prep and service;
- Assist in accepting deliveries and ensuring the standard of produce is in line with BP standards;
- Ensuring presentation of food is compliant with our standards;
- Ensure compliance with all Food Hygiene regulations;
- To ensure that all areas are left as clean and tidy as is reasonably practical at all times;
- Keeping up the standards of all food areas with regard to hygiene and cleanliness;
- To carry out the prep needed, to the standards laid out and assist in the smooth running of the kitchen service;
- To attend meetings and training courses as may be necessary from time to time;
- To report and take necessary action for any incident of fire, accidents, theft, loss, damage, unfit food or any other irregularities;
- To adhere to all statutory requirements regarding fire, health, safety and hygiene;
- To participate in cross/multi skilled training within your department or other departments as deemed appropriate by your Manager;
- To carry out any reasonable instruction as directed by your Manager.
